The programme has been designed for Government Officials, representatives of Central Trade Unions and NGOs with the aim to develop an understanding of the need for social security for informal sector workers and familiarise them with various social security and welfare programmes. The programme will be conducted in English/Hindi. The details about the programme are given in the enclosed brochure.

There is no programme fee. The Institute would provide free boarding and lodging facility and will reimburse to and fro 3 tier AC train fare on production of tickets to the participants.

INTRODUCTION

In India around 93 percent of the workforce are deprived of the benefit of formal social security protection. However in the recent times, provision of social security to unorganized sector workers have assumed great significance. Various efforts have been initiated by the Government of India such as designing of new social security schemes, introduction of innovative methods for identification of beneficiaries, enacting a comprehensive legislation to ensure social protection for unorganized sector workers. These measures have not succeeded in achieving the desired objective partly on account of the ignorance, illiteracy and lack of unionization of workers on the one hand and resource constraints of the state and poor implementation on the other. It is in this context the present training programme has been conceptualized for trade union leaders and government officials with an aim to create understanding of the different social security schemes and programmes, understanding the gaps in implementation and exploring ways for proper implementation of the schemes, so as to benefit the workers in the unorganized sector.

AIM

The programme aims to develop an understanding of the need for social security for workers in the unorganized sector .

THE OBJECTIVES

- Acquaint participants with the concept of social security and the need for social security for informal sector workers
- Develop understanding of the various social security and welfare programmes
- Familiarize participants with different micro level social security experiments

COURSE PROFILE

Overview of social security and welfare programmes, sharing community experiments, strategies for initiating community level programmes

METHODOLOGY

Lectures, interactive sessions, individual and group presentations and case studies

PARTICIPANTS

Government Officials and Representatives of Central Trade Unions and NGOs. We will appreciate if participants from reserved categories (SC/ST/OBC) are also nominated.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Participants should be above **22 years and below 50 years of age**;
2. Should be personally engaged at grass root level activities for at least past two years;
3. Should be fluent in either Hindi or English.

Note:

1. Please note that those who have attended Institute's programme earlier are not to be nominated. If so, they shall be immediately sent back and no travel allowance will be reimbursed.
2. Spouse and family members are not allowed to stay in the Institute's hostel.
3. Only members of trade unions should be nominated. Please ensure that spouse or relatives of nominee, who are not member of trade union, should not be nominated.
4. Participants are requested to book their return ticket in advance from their own place.

STAY ARRANGEMENT

Stay arrangement will be made in the hostel of the V.V. Giri National Labour Institute. Accommodation will be on twin-sharing basis. The boarding and lodging facilities will be provided by the Institute from the afternoon of February 10, 2019 till the forenoon of February 16, 2019. For extended stay or early arrival, lodging & boarding charges would be borne by the participants.

TRAVELLING EXPENSES.

1. The Institute would reimburse travel expenses of the participants for 3 tier AC Train fare from their place of work to NOIDA on production of ORIGINAL ticket for inward journey and for return journey, a photo copy of 3rd AC CONFIRMED ticket shall be produced to claim reimbursement. Without submission of tickets, no reimbursement claim will be permissible. The nominees should be informed about the reimbursement procedure accordingly to avoid inconvenience
2. The local conveyance to be reimbursed would be restricted to the actual expenditure incurred or Rs. 750/- whichever is less.
3. The participants are provided free of cost boarding and lodging only for the duration of the programme.
