CONTEXT

Empowerment of women is essentially the vehicle of change to achieve gender equality that is meaningful and sustainable. And this is closely linked to the opportunities women have in education, health, employment and for political participation. Over the years, significant advancements have been made in India on many of these counts.

Data on literacy rates, enrolment and drop rates in primary education, life expectancy, infant mortality, maternal mortality rates, etc has shown a progressive trend. The female literacy rate in India has risen significantly over the years and more and more women are entering higher levels of education. This is also leading to greater participation of women in the workforce particularly in field like IT and finance. Women are adorning some of the highest political offices in our country. The rise of a million Indian women as *panchayat* leaders is a spectacular achievement. Overall there is an increased visibility of women in every aspect of our lives.

We also but realize that there is still a long way to the situation wherein women can claim to have all the same rights and opportunities as men. In spite of the progress made in various spheres, sex ratio in the age group of 0-6 years and gender-based violence continue to be heavily skewed against women. There are still gender gaps in many areas, which need to be addressed through planned actions

The Government of India, through its various policies measures and programmes is committed to reducing these disparities and focuses on gender equality and women's empowerment. Gender Budgeting is an important tool in this direction for translating gender commitments into budgetary commitments. The Ministry of Women and Child Development, along with Ministry of Finance, has been pursuing Gender Budgeting at various levels.

The most important milestone in this regard has been the institutionalization of the process through formation of Gender Budget Cells in various Ministries and Departments as mandated by the Ministry of Finance in 2005. Subsequently the Ministry of Labour and Employment also has formed a Gender Budget Cell. The need of the day now is to strengthen the Gender Budget Cells so as to ensure systematic process of engendering of their policies, programmes and schemes.

This training programme is one of the key steps towards this. I hope that this training programme will help you understand gender budgeting concepts and tools especially with respect to the Gender Budget Statement. The tools and processes discussed during the technical sessions should help you all to take a fresh look at your budget from a gender lens. This is just the beginning, and it offers an opportunity to share the experiences of various divisions and enable cross learning and discussions. V.V. Giri National Labour Institute, NOIDA will be more than happy to extend all possible form of support required by your organisations to carry forward the GB initiatives.

I trust that you will see this programme not simply as a one-off the event, but as an opportunity for all of you, to carry forward our common agenda for empowering the women in the country.

AIM

The programme aims to orient the participants about gender budget initiatives which have the potential of contributing to the promotion of gender equality with following major objectives:

OBJECTIVES

- To discuss gender issues in Labour
- To identify gender budgeting initiatives of government of India
- To discuss concepts, tools and methods of gender budgeting
- To discuss the Importance of Gender Budgeting and women empowerment.

TRAINING DELIVERY AND METHODOLOGY

This training will be delivered in online mode. The training will primarily be interactive in nature with the provision of case studies; dissemination of documentaries; group work; assignments. Comprehensive literature will also be provided to the participants as a part of this programme.

RESOURCE PERSONS

Faculty members of VVGNNLI and Subject experts will be the primary resource persons.

PARTICIPATION LEVEL

Government Officials, Researchers, Students and Village Heads are expected to apply for this programme. For the welfare of vulnerable and marginalized section of the society, we will appreciate if participants from reserved categories (SC/ST/OBC) are also nominated.

Participants should have working knowledge of Hindi/English Language. Further, as this is an online training, those enrolling in the programme should have access to internet and laptop/desktop /smart phone with audio-visual facilities.

DATES AND DURATION

This programme is scheduled from 13th July to 17th July, 2020. On each day, online lectures and discussion sessions will be held from 12.30p.m to 2.30 p.m. followed by discussion through email and mobile on exercises provided to the participants during/after the end of each online session.
