Further the course will also provide the opportunity to discuss the effect of Covid-19 on the informal workers and economic units.

Objectives

- Provide understanding about the composition and characteristics of the informal economy;
- Learn about the effect of Covid-19 on the informal economy workers and enterprises

The concept of informality and how to measure informality and its main drivers; integrated strategy and institutional framework for transition towards formality; labour reform and enactment of labour codes in India and its implications for transition to formal economy; Extension of social protection and skills development as a formalization strategy; Role of workers and employer's organization in promoting formality; transition to formal economy – sharing of good practices and lessons learnt from national and international level.

- The training will primarily make use of lectures, case studies and experience sharing. It will also include group discussions and thus be participative in nature.

- Comprehensive reference materials will also be suggested as a part of the programme.
